Description: Everybody Rocks classes are our signature class. These classes give students of all ages the chance to explore the various instruments that make up the rock band setting. Age groups help define learning goals: Students have time to experiment with instruments and focus on one song to learn over the course of a given session. The second song and subsequent songs if time permits are often "originals" written and performed by students, utilizing musical knowledge they have accumulated learning their cover song(s). All classes make a "scrapbook" documenting and visually reinforcing what has been learned. Minimum/Maximum class size:5/20. Course is 7 weeks.
