#### **GADGET DAY** 6<sup>th</sup> 7<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> Partner Programs for Middle School Kids. (Limit 20 kids each)

Build A Bike (For boys and girls) Depart Brooks Middle School on a bus with chaperones to Working Bikes, a bicycle repair shop in Chicago, to spend the morning practicing basic bike maintenance and use of tools. Kids will work on bikes provided at the shop, and will tour the warehouse storing hundreds of bikes waiting for repair and shipment overseas to places of need. See workingbikes.org for more on their amazing story and mission.

Kids will return on the bus to Brooks for lunch. Inspired by their morning excursion, the kids will spend the afternoon each constructing a unique art creation from a collection of used bike parts, miscellaneous hardware and random "found" materials.

**Gadget Day Lunch Info:** Each child should bring a sack lunch and beverage. Or, you may order a lunch of Domino's Pizza, clementines and water on the registration form.

Build A Bird At this girls-only camp, girls will build their own chirping Digital Bird. Instructors from *Triton College's GADgET Girls* program (Girls Adventuring in Design, Engineering & Technology) will lead the day's activities. Girls will work with circuit boards, soldering irons and tech tools to build the chirping bird. Once it sings, the girls will add the bird's body and wings from found objects and make it "fly." The program runs the full day at Brooks Middle School, with a break for lunch.
